

CP Preparatory School Health and Wellness Policy effective May 2020

As of May 2020 if you are not an employee of CP Prep School, maintenance worker, police or fire safety you will not be allowed into the building. The students will be escorted from the car into school and escorted back to the car.

- A. Morning drop off is from 6:30-8:30 (breakfast is served from 7:30-8:00) NO OUTSIDE FOOD
- B. ALL students must wear a mask! (Until further notice)
- C. Afternoon pick up times will vary. PLEASE PICK UP IMMEDIATELY AFTER WORK. Please ring the door bell and hold a piece of paper in the window with your child's name and classroom teacher. We will go get your child and bring them out to the car.

The health department regulations prohibit the admittance of any child into school that exhibits any of the following symptoms: If you are called you must pick up within 30 min.

- 1. Fever (100 or higher) child needs to be fever free for 48 hrs. without the aid of any medication. Please do not wake up at 2:00 am and give your child fever reducing medicine to reduce the fever so your child can come to school at 8:00 am. With the seriousness of the Covid 19 this is not acceptable.
- 2. Diarrhea- child must be symptom free for 24 hrs. without the aid of medication.
- 3. Vomiting- child must be symptom free for 24 hrs. without the aid of medication.
- 4. Runny nose with colored discharge – check with your doctor
- 5. Rash- check with your doctor
- 6. Discharge from eyes or ears- check with your doctor
- 7. Lice- child needs to be treated and nits removed before return- check with your doctor
- 8. Signs and symptoms of Covid 19: Fever, tiredness, aches and pains, nasal congestion, runny nose, soar throat, diarrhea, cough, shortness of breath, shakes.
- 9. If you or your child has been knowingly been exposed to COVID 19 DO NOT BRING THEM TO SCHOOL!!! This is for the safety for all children and their families.
- 10. **Communicable Diseases:** Covid 19, Chicken pox, measles, mumps, conjunctivitis (pink eye), influenza etc.
- 11. **The child is able to return to school with a Dr. note once the contagious period is passed and the child is well enough to resume normal activities at school.**

Additional safety measure that need to take place:

- A. Rest mat need to come to school in a king size pillow case with your child's name on it. NO stuffed animals and NO Pillows allowed.
- B. All students need to have a clean pair of shoes to leave at the school. Students will remove shoes in the car and put on their school shoes once they get to class.
- C. If you child is in diapers or pullups Please provide the small doggie poop bags. They are usually available at the dollar store. All diapers and pullup must be disposed of in the bags
- D. NO BACK PACKS ALLOWED! Instead bring 1 plastic 2 pocket folder every day.
- E. NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED until further notice.

MEDICATION: child must be on dr prescribed medication for 48 hrs before they can return to school.

School regulations prohibit giving your child medication of any kind unless you have a filled out and signed medication authorization form to the front office. ALL MEDICATION MUST BE IN THE ORIGINAL LABELED CONTAINER. NO OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATION CAN BE GIVEN WITH A NOTE FROM THE DR.

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If your child is returning to school on May 4th or any day after that you must come up to the school prior to them starting back and fill out a new form.
